Though Japan has been evangelized for over 100 years, still less than <1% of the Japanese believe in Jesus.

- Japan is the # 1 unreached people group in the world.
- Japan is part of the 10-40 Window.
- Japan is part of the 50-50 Porthole.
- Japan has the highest suicide rate in all of Asia.
- Japan is #4 in the world in reported abortions.
- Japan is a shame based society, where the only way to overcome shame is self-sacrifice.
- Though Christianity is not prohibited in Japan, the collectivist attitude of “the nail that sticks our gets hammered in” puts tremendous pressure on individuals to conform to their families and societies traditions.
- Japanese define themselves as Buddhist or Shinto; to be Christian is to not be Japanese.
- Japanese believe Christianity is the religion of the West and the white; it is not for the Japanese.
- Japan is financially and educationally rich but emotionally and spiritually poor.
- Japan’s populations is drastically declining and millions are dying yearly without know Jesus as their savior.
- The 3/11 Tsunami and Earthquake shook the spiritual foundation and societal walls of Japan and people are more open to discussing God and hearing the Gospel.
